

ABC ID for Students

Introduction:- The Ministry of Education (MoE) plays a crucial role in transforming and maintaining a quality educational system across Indian educational institutions. They have introduced several schemes and programs to evaluate and innovate the educational fields for quality assurance. The ABC ID card is one such initiative that helps transform the education system strategically with a crucial approach toward student growth. **ABC ID cards store the academic credits and information of students** in a **digital ID** to keep them safe and secure. The NEP (National Education Policy) launched this program as an initiative from the UGC (University Grants Commission). The MoE (Ministry of Education) and MeitY (Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology) oversee this programme. Students in India can obtain the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID, a unique 12-digit code, to digitally manage, store, and access their academic credits, including certificates, diplomas, degrees, training details, and co-curricular achievements. The ABC ID acts as a link to DigiLocker, where students can securely store essential documents like exam mark sheets. The ABC ID receives students' academic credits from institutions through the National Academic Depository. These credits awarded by registered institutions to a student for a programme will be stored digitally in the ABC, which can be shared or transferred from one institution to another upon students' consent. This streamlines the authentication for admissions or jobs, simplifying the verification of academic records.

ABC ID Full Form: Full form of ABC ID card is the **Academic Bank of Credits**. As the name suggests, it records higher educational credits earned by a student from UGC-recognised institutions, which can be transferred between institutions.

Purpose of ABC ID:

Below are the purposes of ABC ID:

- Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) will help open, close, and validate every student's academic account.
- Apart from gathering students' academic credits, ABC ID verifies them and stores the credits to transfer or promote them as per requirements.
- ABC ID will store credits earned by students from online and distance courses offered by the government of India.
- Students can redeem the credits and seek direct admission at any university in the second year.

Benefits of ABC ID creation: Creating ABC IDs offers numerous benefits, including:

- **Unique Student ID:** The issuance of ABC IDs assigns a distinct and permanent identifier to each student, commencing from Class I. This ensures seamless academic tracking throughout their educational journey.
- **Academic Progress Monitoring:** ABC IDs facilitate continuous and comprehensive monitoring of students' academic performance from the outset.
- **Identifying Weaknesses:** Educators can discern subject-specific weaknesses in students' academic data linked to ABC IDs, enabling targeted interventions for improvement.

Streamlined Record Keeping: The ABC securely stores students' academic records, significantly reducing reliance on traditional paper-based records and alleviating administrative burdens.

Step-by-step Process to generate Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID:

OPTION-A: On ABC Portal:

- 1) Open official website www.abc.gov.in/
- 2) The Click on My Account tab on right hand of the web-page.
- 3) Select Student from the drop-down list and
 - a) If you have account on the DigiLocker follow these steps: • Sign-in using your details and OTP.

b) If you do NOT have account on the DigiLocker follow these steps: • Click on Sign-up for Meri Pehchaan (www.digilocker.meripehchaan.gov.in). Create an account using your Mobile Number linked with your Aadhaar. • Sign-in using your details and OTP.

4) After sign-in, select the University tab from the options and search University name by in the dropdown-list.

5) Click on the University name to complete the Registration Process on ABC.

6) Please note down and keep your ABC ID for future references.

OPTION-B: On DigiLocker Portal (for those who have DigiLocker account)

1) Open official website www.digilocker.gov.in/

2) Click on Search Documents at the left panel and type 'ABC ID' in the search column.

3) Click on ABC ID Card- Academic Bank of Credits in the search results.

4) Select University from the drop-down list in the Institution Type option on your dashboard and click OK.

5) Search University name in the Institution Name option.

6) Click on the University name from the drop-down list and click OK.

7) Check the consent box and click on Get document button.

8) Get your ABC ID by clicking the ABC ID Card option from your Issued Documents list.

9) Please note down and keep your ABC ID for future references.

What would happen if I omit writing an ABC ID number in the online examination form?

2. **Submit Corrected Information:** Follow the instructions provided by your institution to submit the missing or corrected information as soon as possible.
3. **Meet Deadlines:** Ensure that you adhere to any deadlines or timelines provided by your institution to avoid further complications.
